

What does biodegradable mean?

Biodegradability means that in a reasonable amount of time after disposal, the material in the product will break down.

As you know the fact that a product is biodegradable does not mean that a waste water treatment facility can handle that material. That determination can only be made by the waste water treatment facility personnel.

Important factors that they consider are

- Composition of the waste stream
- Quantity of waste being sent to drain
- Concentration
- Frequency of discharge
- Compatibility with filters, membranes, etc used in their treatment equipment
- If everything is ok they will let the end user know.

In the event that material can not go down the drain, a local waste handler can determine the classification of the waste stream.

Note: **Star Metal Fluids LLC, its employees, or represented product manufacturers/suppliers will NOT make claim that any or all goods to be biodegradable.** Again, that the decision to allow material to go down the drain is solely the responsibility of the waste water treatment facility.

The fact that a competitor may have told a customer/prospect that it is ok to send the waste stream to drain does not guarantee that this is a true statement. One needs to know all the local, state and federal regulations to make that determination. Improper disposal can lead to significant fines and/or jail time...
